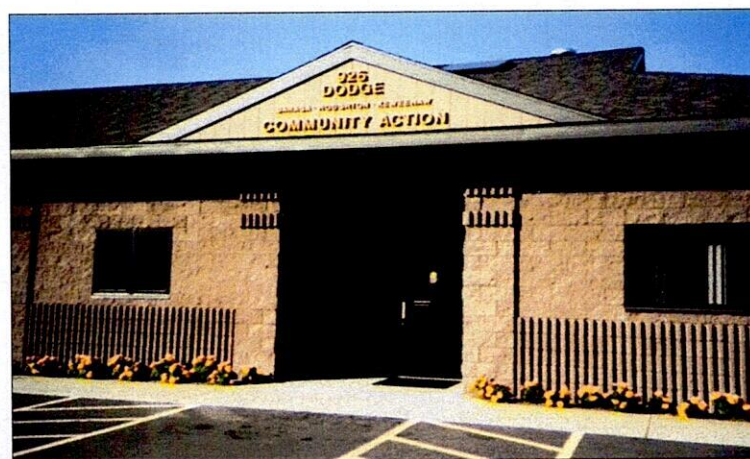

About Us

Since 1965, the Baraga-Houghton-Keweenaw Community Action Agency has been helping individuals and families in the three-county areas.

BHK is a non-profit Community Action Agency governed by a 12-member tri-partite board. The Board is made up of representatives from public, private, and low-income sectors of the community. BHK is funded by federal, state, and local grants as well as private foundations.

In fiscal year 2021, B-H-K Community Action Agency assisted more than 3,500 individuals through fuel assistance, utility assistance, tax assistance, home weatherization, housing assistance, bus rides, food assistance programs, in-home programs for seniors, youth recreation, furnace/chimney cleaning and repair, and the operation of the Keweenaw Handicraft Shop in Ahmeek.



Introduction

Baraga-Houghton-Keweenaw Community Action Agency conducts a needs assessment every three years to ensure that we are doing everything possible to meet the needs of the communities we serve.

Feedback from our Board, the community, and other partners helps us to assess the challenges faced in the community, identify unmet needs, and guide us in our efforts to assist individuals and families as best we can.

Methodology

A survey was distributed at our food distributions and handed out in the office. A separate questionnaire was given to the governing board and local partners/businesses in an effort to work together in enhancing our programs to better meet the needs of the community.

Approximately 140 community surveys were returned.

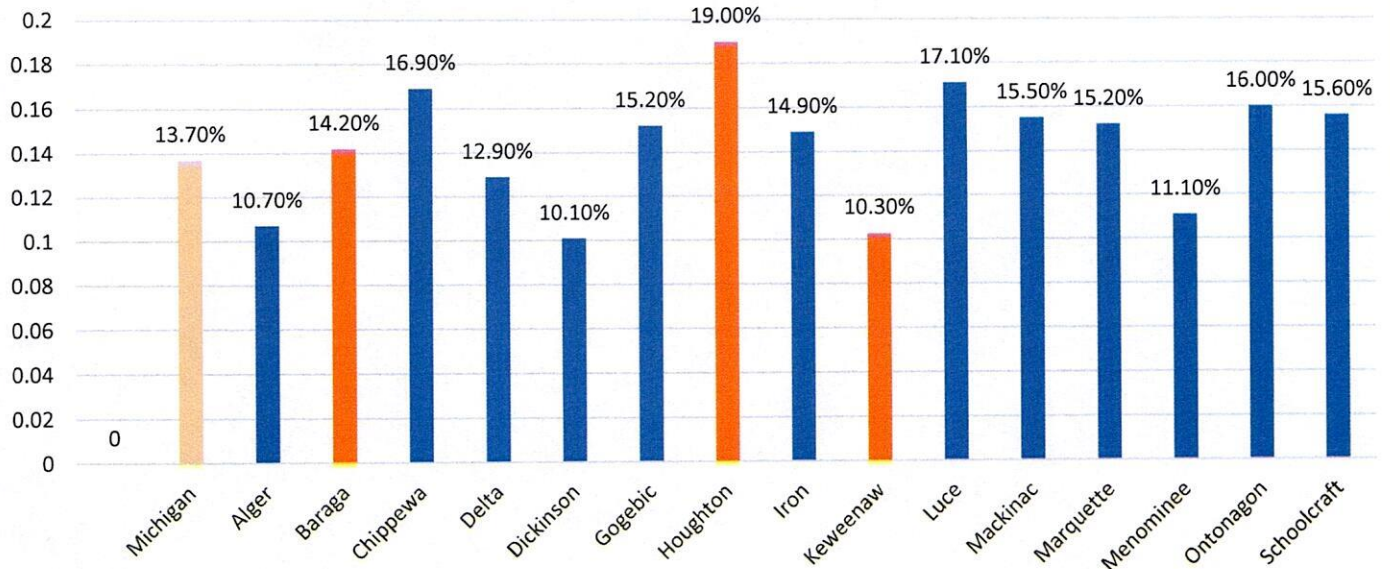

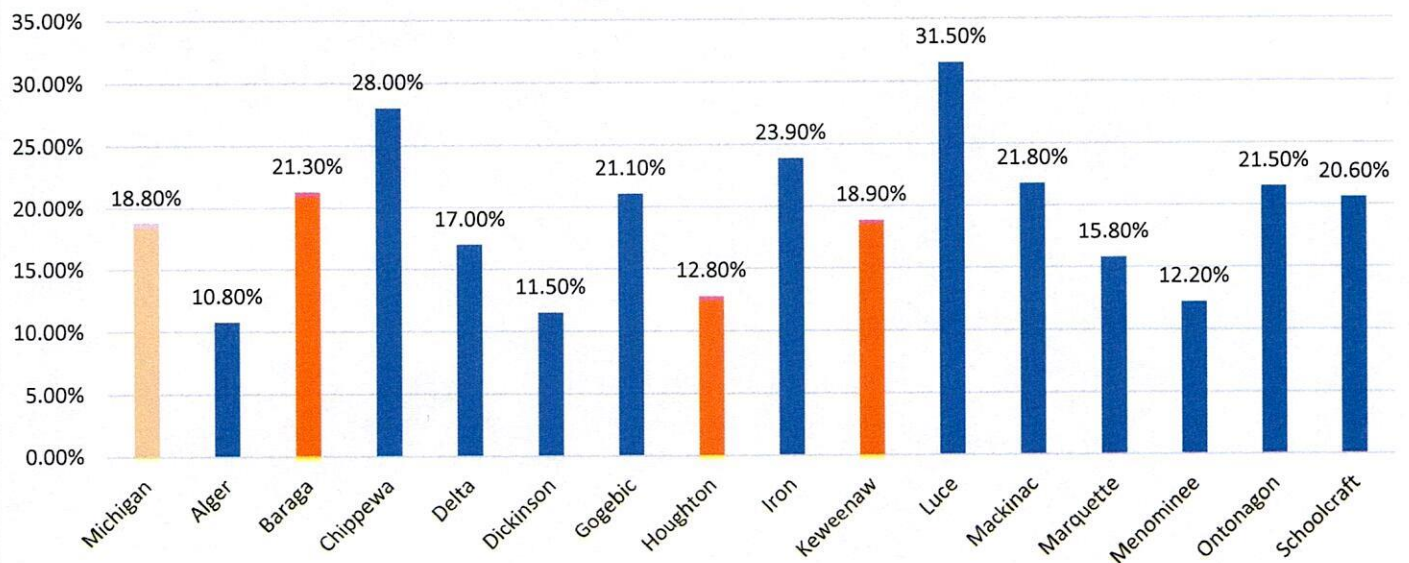
Percent of Population in Poverty

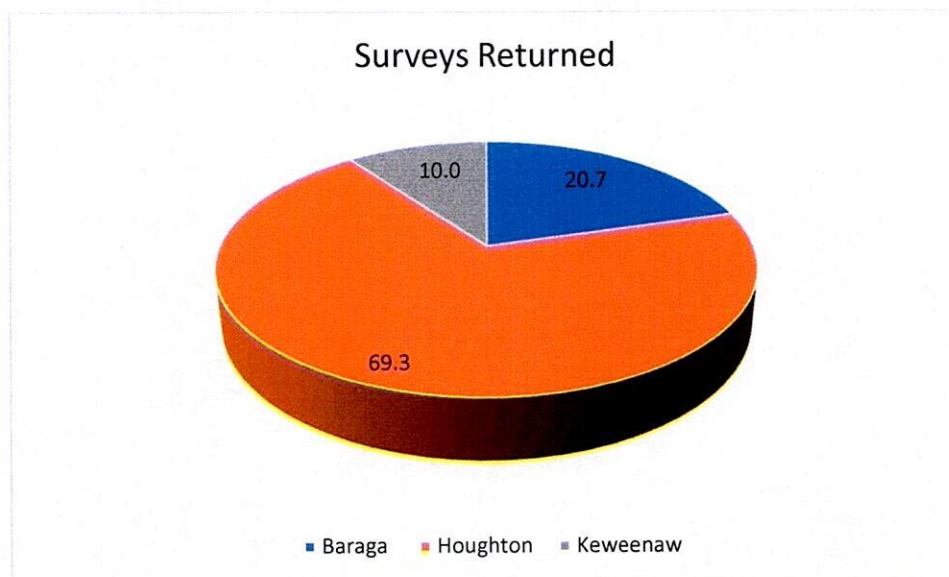


Percent of Children Under 18 Living in Poverty

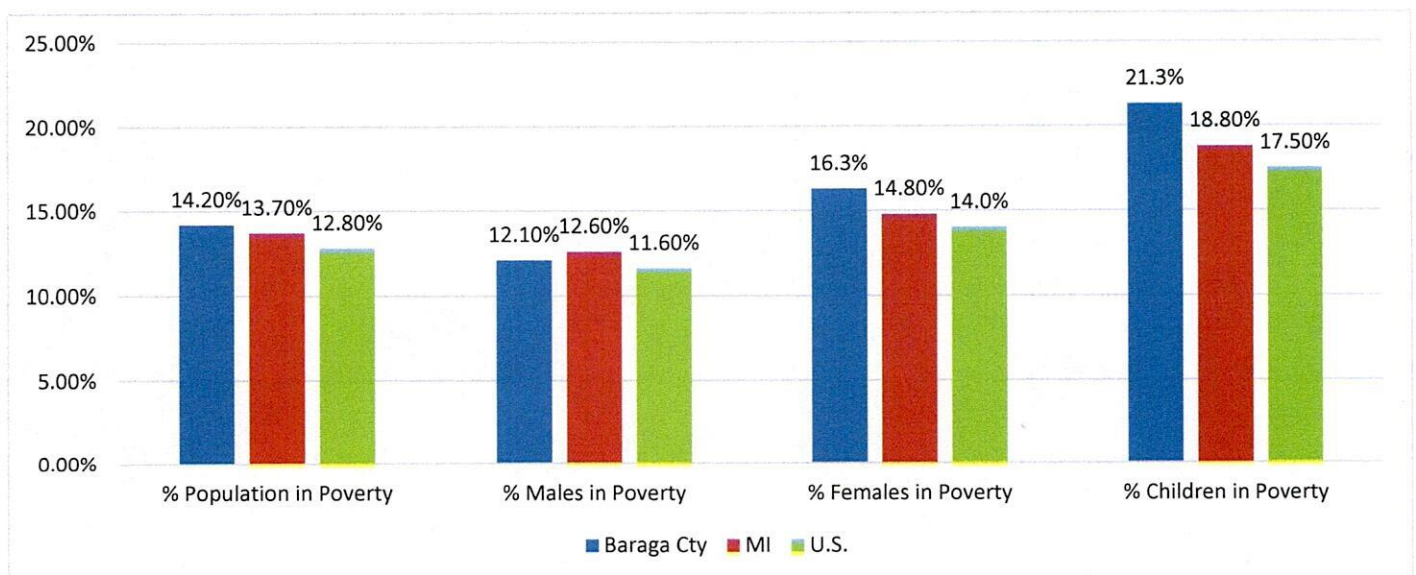

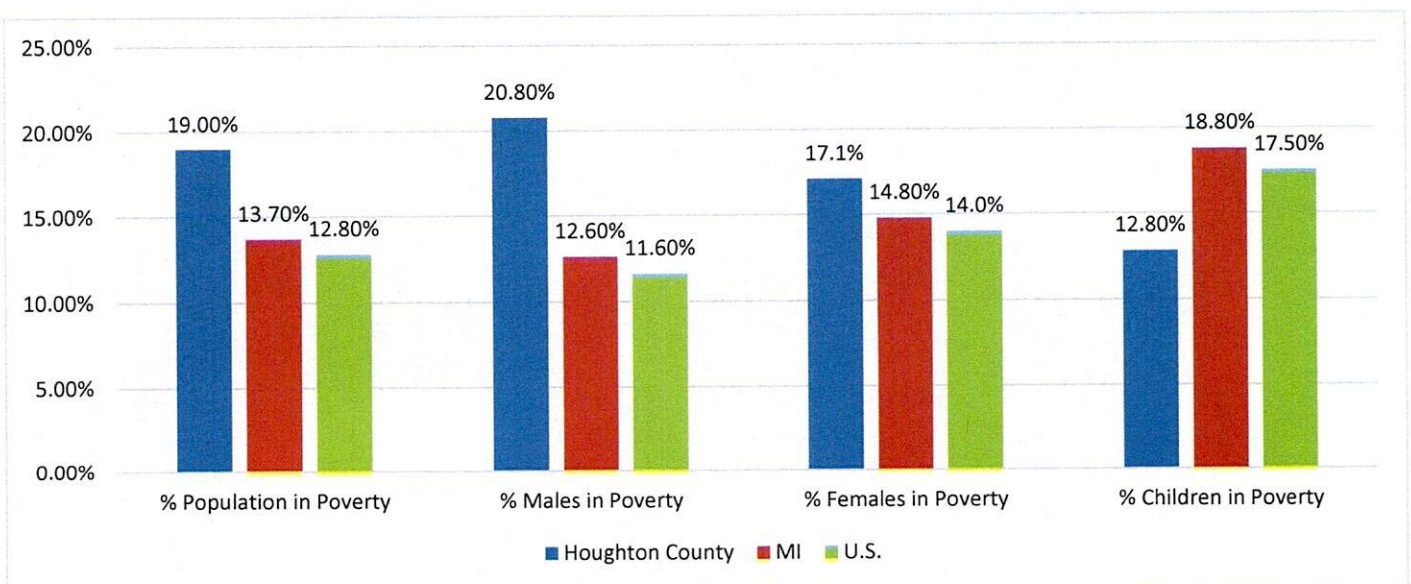

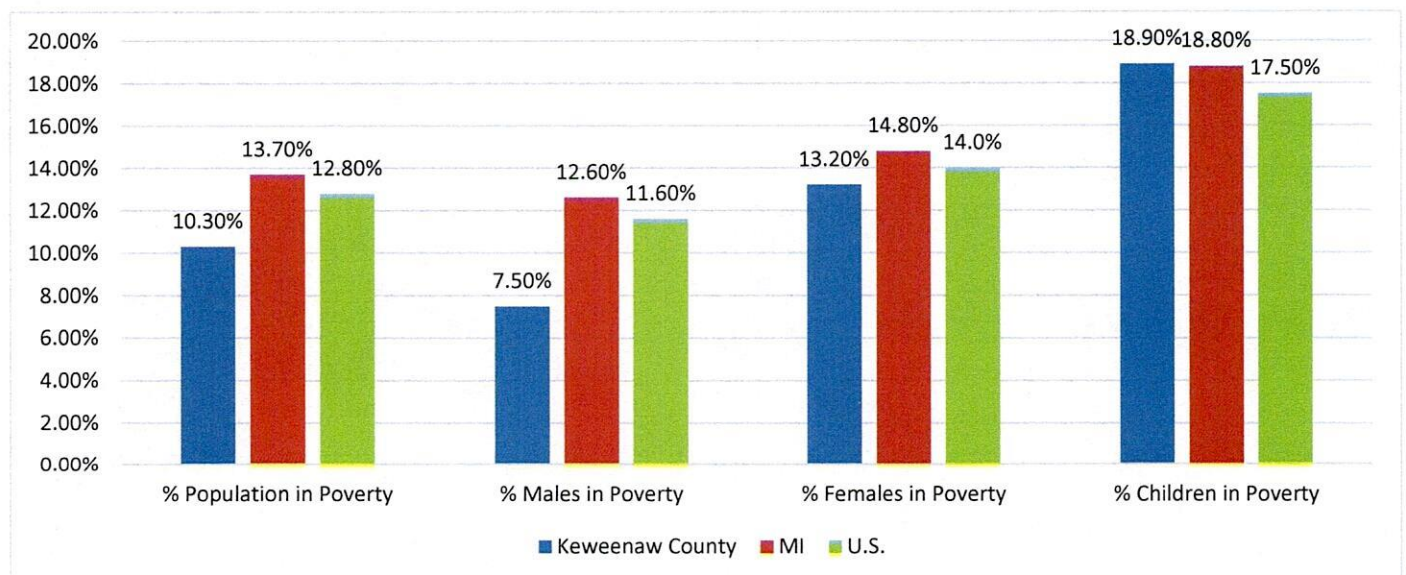

Key Sector Participation

Baraga-Houghton-Keweenaw Community Action Agency reached out to key sectors of the community to collaborate on the needs of the community and how we can work together to meet those needs.

The key sectors included community, faith based, educational, private, and public organizations. If the organization did not already know what services we provide, this was an opportunity to inform them. In addition, we learned what services they provide, what they felt to be the top needs of the community, and ideas of how we can work together to fulfill some of the unmet needs.

The top three needs listed by our partners were reliable transportation, affordable housing, and food. Other needs mentioned included mental health services, rental assistance, employment/living wages, health care costs, child care and service coordination (connecting individuals to programs).

Baraga-Houghton-Keweenaw Community Action Agency is already providing assistance for the top three needs. We have programs that provide food, transportation, as well as housing assistance in the form of utility assistance, minor home repairs, and furnace and/or chimney cleaning.

We will continue to work with our partners in any way we can to help the communities we serve.

Key Findings

Of the three counties in our service territory, only Keweenaw County is below the state poverty level for adults according to data from the American Community Survey 2020. Houghton County is the highest with 19% of the population in poverty. This could be due to the fact that the population is much higher in Houghton County, but the median age is much lower at 33.2. The median age in Baraga and Keweenaw Counties is 45.8 and 58.3 respectively. At age 33, people haven't been in their jobs too long and, therefore, probably earn a much lower salary.

Single parenting can be a cause of poverty. In all three counties, the poverty rate is 20-50% higher in a female household with no spouse. However, according to the data from the same 2020 survey, the percent of children under the age of 18 living in poverty went down in all three counties as well as the state of Michigan.

The median household income is much lower than the state in all three counties. Keweenaw County is the closest, but still \$7,484 below the state's median income. The unemployment rate is lower in all three counties according to the 2020 data. However, the lower income and lower median age still most likely contribute to the higher rates of poverty.

From the surveys returned, the top need listed in all three counties was again food. Heating assistance was the 2nd or 3rd need in all three counties, with housing assistance and repairs also being listed 2nd or 3rd. Baraga-Houghton-Keweenaw Community Action Agency does help with all of these needs currently and plans to continue. The top unmet need is lawn care and snow removal. We will take this into consideration; however, we feel it would be a difficult need to fulfill.

Our Future

Baraga-Houghton-Keweenaw Community Action Agency will continue to work together with our agency partners and strive to alleviate some of the hardships of the clients in our communities.

We will continue to enhance our food programs as this is the top need in each of the counties reported by our respondents as well as a need many of the key sector organizations listed. We will continue providing the other needs as funding allows and attempt to find funding for needs we do not currently provide.

Our goal is to ease the burden of these high-cost times as much as possible for our clients and the communities we serve.

We will also continue our efforts to help with service coordination by making sure other organizations know what services we offer and by knowing what others offer so we can assist clients in getting the help they need.
