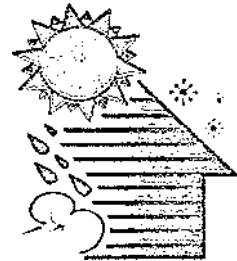


Baraga-Houghton-Keweenaw Community Action Agency

- Combustion Appliance Testing for safety and efficiency. (Includes refrigerator, furnace, and hot water heater)
- Health and Safety Inspection

Interested Homeowners/Renters must meet current Income Guidelines, which includes gross income of everyone residing in the home at the time of application. Recipients of FIP or SSI during any part of the past twelve months are automatically income eligible.
